Dear Secretary Sebelius,

I am submitting this letter in response to your request concerning Virginia's intent to contract with the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) for the development of a temporary high-risk pool under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010.

The Commonwealth of Virginia will not establish and serve as a vendor of a temporary high-risk pool. Virginia has estimated that the funding available to the Commonwealth in the amount of \$113 million plus or minus 1% will not cover costs of the program beyond 22 months. This concern has been reinforced by actuaries from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services who have advised states that "by 2011 and 2012 the initial \$5 billion in federal funding for this program would be exhausted, resulting in substantial premium increases to sustain the program." The Commonwealth will rely on HHS to implement and operate the program as required in section 1101 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2009.
